OVERVIEW

Providence Presbyterian Church supports MMIA by collecting items for the “Homeless Veteran Stand Down” which is an event held in Raleigh each year in mid Oct. A list of items they need can be found on their website <http://militarymissionsinaction.org>. This list is placed on the M&O bulletin board. Since the program is called fill the locker, Margie and Rick Taylor will provide their footlocker which is then placed outside the upper fellowship hall. During the month of Sept. PPC collects health & hygiene items and places them in the designated locker. Announcements are placed in the online newsletter and the Friday reminders. It is also placed in the Sunday bulletin. The first week in Oct. MMIA comes to PPC to collect these items. They distribute them to low income veterans at a yearly event in Raleigh held in mid Oct.
